Post-Op Instructions

Driver For outpatient procedures a driver will be required to take you home and preferably stay

with you overnight. Please do not drive for 24 hours or while taking pain medication.

Follow-up Please call to schedule your first follow-up appt, if not already scheduled.

Medication Begin taking your antibiotic (cephalexin) the day after surgery. Please finish all of this

medication.

Bathing You may shower the day following surgery, just be cautious not to rub the surgical site.

Sutures Removed at 3-7 days.

Activity Refrain from vigorous activity for ONE to TWO weeks after surgery. Excessive activity can

cause bruising, swelling and generally hamper the results.

Swelling Expect significant bruising and swelling for approximately three weeks after surgery,

although slight swelling may last up to a year. Apply ICE to the surgical site for the first 48

hours after surgery.

Dressing Leave dressing in place. This will be removed at your post operative visit, but likely

replaced to limit swelling for approximately 2-3 weeks. If there is nasal packing this will be removed within the first week. If you feel that the packing has moved or is choking you,

please call me or remove the packing in an emergency.
